I mean, if it's artillery, you won't hear anything until the rounds impact. My job skill in the army was a 13 Fox, so a forward observer for the artillery. My job was to support the infantry or with the Cav Scouts or whoever needed it. I fought alongside them, if they got into firefights, I was right there with them. But if they ran across something that was too big for normal M16's or M4's or whatever, I could call in either artillery support to blow it up, or I can talk to Naval gunfire, the Air Force for Air Force planes to come in and help. I mean, that's what I did.

You make the call, you send the coordinates and then you've got the time to wait. You can train, and train and train the first couple of times you do it in combat or in a combat zone you always get that feeling in the bottom of your stomach, I hope I didn't... I hope I'm not off on this. Probably the biggest responsibility is the unknown. The things that you can't see whatsoever, that little berm only over there that you can't see across because you can't get to it. What's on the other side of those trees right there? It's kind of an emotional detachment. You don't always have a whole lot of emotions about the things that are going on, especially not in the heat of the moment. I mean, emotions are great things, but if they get in the way, they can mean you don't come home. So you got to kind of detach yourself from things sometimes.
