We making the Italian bread in the mixer. About 20 minutes and we're ready to start rolling and we make the Italian bread.

Speaker 2 (00:10):

How much... I mean like, how many pounds of dough you got going in?

Speaker 1 (00:12):

I believe it's about 150 pounds right now. My name is John Avgerinos. I'm located 4711 Eastern Avenue. It be a bakery for 35 years I have it. My daddy owns it before. We make everything here. Koulourakia, kourabiedes, [Anasetos 00:00:35] baklava, egg custard and more. We came from Greece from 1969. We

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worked seven days a week to try to make it. Usually, I used to get up three o'clock in the morning. At the time you are baker, you get up early in the morning. Early birds got their worm.

Speaker 2 (<u>00:57</u>): What's the most difficult part of the job?

Speaker 1 (<u>01:01</u>): To get up in the morning.

Speaker 2 (<u>01:04</u>): What keeps you going? What keeps you wanting to get up every morning and do this?

Speaker 1 (<u>01:11</u>): We got to make a living. That's it. We got to make a living.
